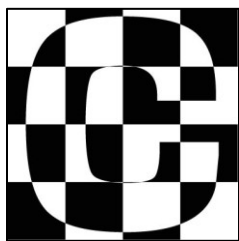
Loyola Elementary Chess Club **Thursdays, from 3-4PM in the School Library**

The chess club is starting again with Coach Andrew Strommen at Loyola! This class is available to all Loyola students who are just beginning or are already well versed in chess. Awards will be given to those students showing knowledge in the very basic through very advanced chess principles.

During our class, students will be given new ideas to play with over the board, to practice with classmates, at home, or anywhere around the world. Periodically, students will be tested for these skills and receive recognition for achieving ever higher levels of aptitude. Then, they will be given the opportunity to use those concepts while in a formal US Chess Federation-regulation tournament setting. All students will be fully prepared to compete well in **NATIONALLY RATED TOURNAMENTS** in a short period of time by Coach Andrew.

Because K-3rd grade students are released from school early, they must meet Coach Andrew at the picnic tables outside the library directly after school, until the allotted time for chess class to start. This time will prove to be valuable as extra time for testing, learning, casual play, and most of all, safety after school. Also, prompt pick-up after chess class is very important. Parents will be billed \$20 for every 15 minutes after 4:15PM that they are late in picking up their child(ren).

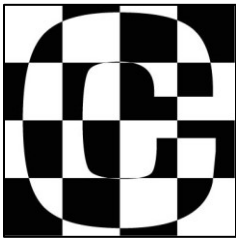
