Wednesdays, from 1:20-2:20PM in the School Library

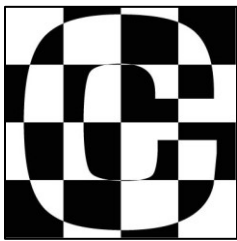
The chess club is starting again with Coach Andrew Strommen at Parkmont! This class is available to all Parkmont students who are just beginning or are already well versed in chess. Awards will be given to those students showing knowledge in the very basic through very advanced chess principles.

During our class, students will be given new ideas to play with over the board, to practice with classmates, at home, or anywhere around the world. Periodically, students will be tested for these skills and receive recognition for achieving ever higher levels of aptitude. Then, they will be given the opportunity to use those concepts while in a formal US Chess Federation-regulation tournament setting. All students will be fully prepared to compete well in **NATIONALLY RATED TOURNAMENTS** in a short period of time by Coach Andrew.

Students will be continually tested for them to achieve higher levels of learning and competition. Also, along with parent support at home, our chess players will learn how to turn every win, loss or draw into a chance for numerous learning opportunities.

Prompt pick-up after chess class is very important. Parents will be billed \$20 for every 15 minutes after 2:45PM that they are late in picking up their child(ren).

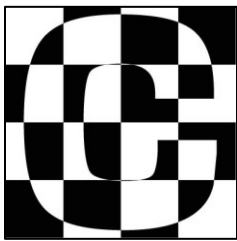
